- Weekly Farm Volunteer** - Reliable weekly volunteers may select alternate times to suit their own and the farm’s schedule. However, volunteers choosing these shifts must be very prompt and plan to come most weeks. We work at these times May through October. Indicate when you are available:
 - Tuesdays from 7:00 am to noon
 - Wednesdays from 7:00 am to 11:00 am
 - Wednesdays from noon to 3:00 pm
